If you want to study English, the best way to learn is to go and live in an English-speaking country. The most popular countries to go to are the United Kingdom, the United States, Canada, Australia and New Zealand. They all use [16] the same kind of English and, with the influence of modern media, people are aware of the vocabulary differences, different accents and different turns of phrases [17] each country has. [18], there is little problem in communication between different nationalities. In fact, if you see movies made in England or movies made in the United States, it is now very common to find actors from England performing [19] Americans in American movies and American actors performing as English people in English movies. They will have to change [20] accents to be convincing and also decide what kind of American accent or what kind of English accent they should use. In the United States, accents will vary [21] region to region. There is the strong twang of the Brooklyn accent in New York. In the political world, perhaps the best-known speaker of this accent is Bernie Sanders. Then there is the southern accent of, for example, the former president of the United States, Bill Clinton, [22] Arkansas accent differs from his wife, Hillary's more standard American accent. England, being an old country, also has a wide range of accents. There is the famous Queen's English which, apart from the Queen, is spoken by [23] a very small number of aging aristocrats. Even [24] grandsons, William and Harry, do not now speak in the same way as their grandmother, the Queen. What used to be a standard BBC television accent is now [25] longer very common and one of the BBC's principal newscasters speaks with a gentle Welsh accent from England's western neighboring country, Wales.
