#### (注) insomnia: 不眠症

NHS: National Health Service イギリスの国民保健サービス(通称 NHS)

GP: General Practitioner 一般開業医、家庭医

- ① Insomnia patients in London have been using an app as a treatment option for decades.
- ② Insomnia patients in London prefer to take sleeping pills rather than taking care of their sleep habits.
- ③ The National Institute for Health and Care Excellence (NICE) encourages the use of Sleepio as a new treatment option for insomnia patients.
- The National Institute for Health and Care Excellence (NICE) is concerned that insomnia patients might get addicted to Sleepio.
- ⑤ Changes to the guidelines for insomnia may positively affect up to 800,000 people.
- ⑤ Sleepio is a new treatment option for insomnia patients, but it also costs more compared to usual treatments.
- After using Sleepio, users tend to increase the number of appointments with their GP.
- Though the self-help programme is designed to be completed in six weeks, NHS patients are allowed access to it for 12 months.
- The self-help programme users can either fill in a daily diary by hand or use a compatible device that automatically uploads data.
- Sleepio does not produce results that are as good as the usual treatments for insomnia patients.
