The following weeks in the semester will adopt a task-based approach to language learning. Task will be primarily aimed at improving students' oral and general English speaking skills. Students will have a certain amount of autonomy in choosing tasks. Care will be taken to ensure that the students have a variety of interesting tasks aimed at improving, accuracy, fluency, complexity of language and motivation. In particular, selected tasks will: (1) provide lots of meaningful input; (2) promote accuracy and complexity of students' output; (3) focus on form; and (4) increase fluency.

Tasks will also be chosen to help students in areas of particular weaknesses.

Depending on the students' interests and other reasons, there may be some deviations from the course schedule outlined below.

Week 1	Speaking, ice- breaking, and course outline.	In this class, students will gain an orientation regarding the course objectives. Learners will participate in group activities.				
Week 2	Four skills (reading writing listening and speaking),	Introducing human relationships, personalities, and revising the simple present tense versus the present continuous.				
Week 3	Four skills (reading writing listening and speaking), vocabulary and grammar.	Introducing our memories of past events and milestones in our lives. Revising the simple past tense.

Week 7	Four skills (reading writing listening and speaking), vocabulary and grammar.	The topic of unsolved mysteries will be introduced. Adverbs of manner will be reviewed and reading and writing activities will be a part of this lesson.		
Week 8	Four skills (reading writing listening and speaking), vocabulary and grammar.	The modern family unit will be discussed. Students will learn to politely disagree with people. Students will also be introduced to stress-timed speech and this will be contrasted to the syllable-timed speech of Japanese. Students will also use expressions of quantity.		
Week 9	Four skills (reading writing listening and speaking),	This lesson will include the topic of style, fashion, and modern trends. Students will practise giving advice to people.		
Week 10	Four skills (reading writing listening and speaking), vocabulary and grammar.	Talking about places to go int the high street. Reviewing places to go shopping. We will also look at reduced forms in language and learn how to use modal expressions effectively.		
Week 11	Four skills (reading writing listening and speaking), vocabulary and grammar.	Talking about facilities and issues in your neighbourhood. Learners will describe places and use imperative forms to give instructions.		
Week 12	Four skills (reading writing listening and speaking), vocabulary and grammar.	Talking about student life and preparing to go to university. Students will practice reduced forms for going to (gonna). and talking about the future.		
Week 13	Four skills (reading writing listening and speaking),	Students will talk about what they will do after graduation. Students will talk about their plans and predictions for the future.		
Week 14	Four skills (reading writing listening and speaking), vocabulary and grammar.	Bringing it together. Students will have the opportunity to use the language that they have learnt throughout the semester and will be asked to give short presentations.		

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
