講義計画					

Aims:

This course takes a process approach to writing. This means that students will get the oportunity to produce drafte and get feedback from peers and from the teacher. Throughout the writing process, the students' knowledge of expressions used in written work will increase. In addition to becoming a more competent, resourceful and fluent writer, the students will also improve their accuracy in use of English grammar and use.

Outline

In the first two weeks, the students will learn the course goals and become comfotable with using computers and word-processing software.

In week 3 students will practice writing four paragraph essays. They will spend time planning and structuring various kinds of essays. Students will have to produce four essays and a learning journal. For each essay students will receive two feedback sessions from the teacher. Students will also be required to peer assess each others work. This process will continue to week 13.

In week 14 students will be required to submit their portfolio of work to the teacher. This includes their three best essays and their learning journals.

In the final week, students will produce a short final piece of writing for the teacher. This final assignment will not be assessed.
