授業テーマ	Students will improve writing skills to a high level through a variety of topics and writing styles.		
目的と概要	The aims of this course are for students 1) to learn more about different styles of writing for different purposes and audiences, 2) to improve basic skills such as description, comparison, narrative, etc., 3) to develop flexibility and creativity, 4) to learn more about problems of translating Japanese ideas into English, and 5) to prepare for writing high level research papers.		
成績評価法	Students will be graded on a variety of assignments of various lengths. Depending of need, grammar points will be reviewed and tested. For most assignments, 2 grades will be given: one for format, grammar, appropriateness of style, and the second for ideas, thinking and creativity. Tests, homework and in-class activities will be 25% of the final grade; longer assignments will be 75%.
